A Reserve Police Officer I performs law enforcement and public safety duties by patrolling business and residential areas on foot and by vehicle to provide protection of life and property, to enforce laws and ordinances, investigating criminal acts, performing traffic functions, to assist citizens in emergency/hazardous situations and conducting background investigations. Police work involves a great deal of public contact and employees are exposed to various hazards and are subject to OSHA standards on bloodborne pathogens.

QUALIFICATIONS

- General Certificate from the N C Criminal Justice Training and Standards or the N C Sheriff's Training and Standards or five years of previous law enforcement experience
- Excellent physical and mental condition and able to pass examinations by a physician and psychologist;
- Excellent personal and employment history;
- Valid NC driver's license and good driving record;
- Course work at the college level in criminal justice, psychology, sociology, and related subjects preferred.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Must be able to physically perform the basic life operational functions of standing, walking, hearing, kneeling, reaching, feeling, grasping, pushing, pulling, bending, climbing, crawling, fingering and performing medium work, exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, 20 pounds frequently, and 10 pounds constantly. Must possess the visual acuity to operate a police vehicle and distinguish details and differences when observing people, places or things.
