Cheerleader/Parent Responsibilities & Coach Expectations

Cheerleading should be a fun, positive experience for all. Some cheerleaders are at a different beginning point, depending on past cheerleading experiences and individual commitment to the sport. The primary goal is not Wins & Losses. Cheerleaders should expect to improve their technical skills, tactical understanding of the sport and their ability to use both to improve their level of team play.

Cheerleader Responsibilities

- To be present and on time to practices and games.
- Adhere to your practice calendar
- Come prepared for practice (ex: pom poms and tennis shoes - no flips or sandals)
- Come prepared for games (ex: dressed in complete uniform, tennis shoes & poms)
- Notify your coach at least 1 hour before practice or a game, if you will not make it.
- No gum chewing during practice or games.
- No jewelry is to be worn to practice or games.
- Work hard during practice and at home. Do your best to improve as a cheerleader.
- Stay in formation and pay attention to the games. No cutting up with squad members.
- Respect your coaches and teammates.
- Always display a high level of good sportsmanship.

Parent Responsibilities

- Let the coaches coach. Coaching from the sideline is prohibited.
- Provide transportation to practices and games. Please have your child arrive 10 minutes before practice and 30 minutes before games.
- Support the Jackets by getting involved.
- Be your child's biggest fan.
- Support and cheer all squad members on the team
- Support the coaches' expectations.
- If you need to talk with a coach, please do so before or after practice.

Coach Expectations

- Be on time to practices and games. We will contact each Cheerleader or parent for cancellations
- Design practices for the appropriate development of the team.
- To work with all Cheerleaders regardless of skill level.
